

GLOBAL PET EXPO COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Based on recent trends and regulatory guidance, Global Pet Expo Management is adjusting its precautionary measures. We will continue to monitor the situation with COVID-19 and any changes in health authorities' guidelines and may revisit these protocols accordingly.

Face Covering:

Face coverings are encouraged but optional for all attendees.

Proof of Vaccination:

We will not require Attendees to show proof of vaccination to attend Global Pet Expo.

Health Acknowledgement

Please make sure that you have reviewed any advisories or restrictions that may be in place for travel to Florida for international travelers. By attending Global Pet Expo, you are confirming that you and all persons in your party:

- Are not experiencing any of the following symptoms of COVID-19 identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention at [CDC.gov](https://www.cdc.gov), including:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Do not need to quarantine due to close contact with someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19
- Are not under any self-quarantine orders

Attendees who cannot confirm all of the above criteria cannot attend Global Pet Expo. If at any point during Global Pet Expo, an Attendee does not meet all of the above criteria, they will not be eligible to attend the Global Pet Expo in person.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any community setting where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and attendees with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.
