Two-thirds of backyard chicken owners consider them to be pets.












Close to half keep chickens for their eggs and, interestingly, almost a third say they have show birds.

When we look at the amount of backyard chicken owners within each living situation, there are some surprises.

Among homeowners, a whopping


15% say they own backyard chickens.

Even more interesting, while the incidence of those who live in a condo/co-op is small overall, among that group almost a quarter of folks own backyard chickens! Additionally, almost 10% of renters say they have backyard chickens.

(Most of these condo/co-ops are in urban areas with populations

over 2.5 million).





The main supplies purchased for backyard chickens are feed, feeders, coops and chicken runs.
